Every day, the West Chester Area Senior Center fulfills its important mission to enrich the lives of our senior neighbors through friendship, activities, education, and nourishment. Our Center offers 3,500 greater West Chester Area seniors over 50 programs including:

- SilverSneakers, Low-Impact Aerobics, Arthritis Exercise, Tai Chi, Yoga & Zumba
- Digital Photography, Language Clubs, Computer Classes, and Financial Workshops
- Annual Tax Assistance in partnership with AARP volunteers
- Monthly Food Box Program in conjunction with the Chester County Food Bank
- Medicare Counseling, Resource Referrals, and Health & Wellness Workshops
