Medicare 2012 Annual Election Period is October 15 to December 7. Take the opportunity to review your Medicare approved health and drug plan options. Sign up for a counseling session with an APPRISE volunteer who will assist you in making an informed decision.

Volunteers will be here on November 18, and December 2 from 9 to 3. Please call the Center to make an appointment at 610-431-4242. Please bring your Medicare and Insurance cards and a list of medication and dosages.
